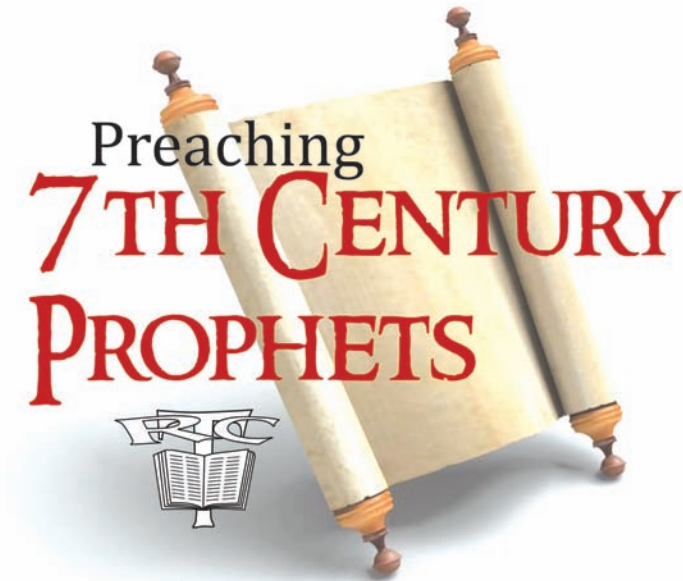

# Speakers

## Rev Martin Pakula



Martin was brought up Jewish in the eastern Suburbs of Sydney. He became a Christian while studying at University. He worked for several years as a minister in the Anglican church, and also in an independent outreach ministry to Jews. He currently lectures at BCV in Old Testament studies. Martin has written a commentary on Numbers in the Anglican Press series 'Reading the Bible Today'.

## Rev Alastair McEwen



Alastair has taught Old Testament and Hebrew at the RTC for over 25 years. He also serves as the Pastor to a congregation in Melbourne and knows the joys and challenges of preaching each week. He brings his extensive knowledge and love of the Old Testament to enrich our understanding of these four 7th Century Prophets.

## Dr Murray Capill

Murray is the RTC's Principal and as the College's preaching lecturer he has spoken at each of our seven previous preaching workshops. He will open this year's conference with a sermon on the prophecy of Zephaniah.

## Dr Bill Berends

Following many years of missionary service in Kenya and Nigeria, Bill joined the faculty of the RTC 1992 when he began as lecturer in systematic theology, ethics and apologetics. Bill also heads up the RTC's Distance Education program. He'll be speaking on the eschatology of the 7th century prophets.
